**SaskTel High Speed Internet Commitment Pricing Program Terms of Service**

1. This is a contract between you and SaskTel. It spells out the terms and conditions which apply to your participation in SaskTel's High Speed Internet Commitment Pricing Program (the "Program"). Customers who sign up for the 24 month Program will receive \$5.00 per month off the price of their SaskTel High Speed Service.
2. The SaskTel High Speed Internet Commitment Pricing Program is only available on High Speed Plus and High Speed Extreme services. N

3. SaskTel reserves the right to change the amount of the discount, the amount of the early termination fee or any other aspect of the Program at any time. Customers will be informed of any changes affecting their account 30 days prior to the change taking effect.
4. By selecting the High Speed Internet Commitment Pricing Program option, you agree to maintain your High Speed Service with SaskTel for a period of 24 months from the time you choose to participate in the Program. You may upgrade from your SaskTel High Speed Internet offering at anytime to a higher speed Internet service or any SaskTel **Max**<sup>TM</sup> Service offering that includes a high speed internet component, and such upgrade will not trigger the early termination fee described in Section 5 below. If prior to the completion of the 24 month commitment you choose to terminate your SaskTel High Speed Internet service or downgrade to a lower speed Internet service or SaskTel's Dial Internet service offering, an early termination charge of \$99.00 plus applicable taxes will be payable by you at the time of termination of your SaskTel High Speed service, and such charge will appear on your SaskTel services bill.
